- The Alberta Legislature grounds are wheelchair accessible. Anyone arriving at the Legislature • using a DATS bus will be dropped off and picked up at the ETS Transit Centre just off 107 Street.

#### How should I plan to travel to the rally?

#### **ANSWER**

There are many ways to get to the rally.

## A. Free Park and Ride

Buses will depart from each of the following 5 locations from 11:00 am to 12:15 pm:

St. Albert - Naki Transit Centre	15520 Campbell Road
Eaux Claires Transit Centre	97 Street and 157 Avenue
Sherwood Park - Bethel Transit Terminal	650 Bethel Drive
Heritage Valley Park and Ride	Ellerslie Road and 127 Street
Davies Transit Centre (*new)	75 Street south of Wagner Road

#### Park and Ride Rally Departures

- Park and Ride buses will depart from the ETS Transit Centre on the East side of the Legislature between 2:15 PM 3:15 PM.
- Buses returning to Sherwood Park will load and depart from 109 Street, north of 99 Avenue between 2:15 PM and 3:15 PM.
- Charter buses will be loading along 109 Street North of 99 Ave between 2:15 PM and 2:45 PM.

## QUESTION

#### What is the rally schedule?

#### ANSWER

Plan to arrive at the Legislature between 11:30AM and 12:30PM so that you can:

- Grab some lunch or a snack at one of the food trucks on 99th Avenue
- Make your own sign in the rally tent by the ATA statue on the East side of the Legislature grounds
- Enjoy some live music from the steps of the Legislature.
- Take photos to share on social media
- Post a short video of yourself at the rally about why you are Standing for Public Education.
- Pick up a rally scarf.
- Find stickers, temporary tattoos and face painting for the kids.

The formal rally program is from 1:00 - 2:00 pm and will include a mixture of inspiring speakers, music, and other entertainment.

## QUESTION

## Will there be security and medical help at the rally?

## ANSWER

- Emergency Medical Services will be parked east of the Legislature steps.
- The Legislature Sheriffs will be on-site throughout the duration of the event.
- Rally volunteers and marshals will be wearing pink vests and can provide information and assistance.
- A tent will be located near the ATA statue on the East side of the Legislature (near the ETS Park and Ride drop off location) that will act as a lost and found area as well as if children become separated from their parents.
