

Political Engagement Grant

To support the development of meaningful relationships between locals and elected officials, the Alberta Teachers' Association offers an annual Political Engagement Grant.

Locals that develop a political engagement plan may be eligible for a grant in the amount of one-half of the cost of implementing the plan to a maximum of \$600. The grant may be paid in two installments, the first to a maximum of \$300 on approval of a political engagement plan and the remainder on receipt of expenses and a report of activities undertaken.

If the plan is approved, funds will be transferred electronically to your local.
