

New! Alberta Week-Long In-person exchange

How does the Alberta week-long in-person exchange work?

The Alberta exchange is a one-week experience with another teacher or school leader in Alberta. This job-shadow opportunity allows you as a professional to learn more about what teaching and leading looks like in another part of our province. Embark on a journey that will inspire, inform, and transform!

See first-hand what it's like in a different setting and learn from one another, and engage in an exchange that is immersive, enlightening, connecting, and invigorating!

You will stay with your exchange partner and job-shadow at your partner's school for the first part of the week, Monday and Tuesday. Wednesday, you both travel to your community so you and your partner can job shadow at your school Thursday and Friday. You can arrange weekend cultural activities as well to start and finish your exchange journey together.

Matches can be throughout Alberta, depending on the applications received, but generally placements will be within three hours of travel.

When does the Alberta week-long exchange happen?

It is previewed to take place in late April or May, based on timing that works for both participants.

How much does the Alberta week-long exchange cost?

Each of you take turn hosting your partner in your home. The program will reimburse mileage to and from your exchange location, as well as replacement costs as necessary.

What does EEP provide?

EEP secures the exchange and provides program support throughout the exchange process.
