Fewer Classroom Distractions, More Engaged Students

74%

of teachers say everyday classroom interruptions are down with the cellphone ban.

Improved Student Well-Being and Mental Health

66%

of teachers report better student mental health since phones left the classroom.

Enhanced Academic Performance

57%

of teachers already notice improved student academic performance.
