WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP?

- superintendents of schools employed by school divisions
- teachers employed
 - by the Government of Alberta,
 - as faculty members in public colleges,
 - by the Association or any of its local associations,
 - in community education programs operated by agencies other than school divisions,
 - by the Alberta Teachers' Retirement Fund Board or
 - by charter schools.
- members of the College of Alberta School Superintendents (CASS)
- members of the faculties of education of the universities in Alberta
- teachers engaged in teacher education in private colleges affiliated with any of the universities in Alberta
- teachers in private schools or kindergartens
- unemployed teachers
- teachers pursuing further studies on a full-time basis
- retired teachers
- Elders, Knowledge Keepers and Cultural Advisors and noncertificated educators employed by First Nations school authorities
- persons not eligible for active membership employed by school divisions such as social workers, psychologists, therapists or clinicians
- other persons or classes of persons that the Provincial Executive Council may designate, from time to time, subject to the ratification of the Annual Representative Assembly

TEACHER

A person holding a permanent or temporary certificate of qualification as a teacher issued by the minister under the *Education Act*.

ACTIVE MEMBERS

Teachers (full time, part time and temporary) employed by an Alberta public, separate or francophone school division are considered active members from their first day of teaching.

SUBSTITUTE TEACHERS

employed by public, separate and francophone school divisions are considered active members from the first day teaching until the end of the school year or until they are no longer on the approved substitute roster of any school division, whichever occurs first.
